WHEREAS, monies awarded from the Federal 5311 Capital Grant will be used for the purchase of the bus shelter and are in the 2021 budget line A56305.52015, AND

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 161-21 approved a contract with Brasco International, Inc. for the purchase of the bus shelter, AND

WHEREAS, there are legal issues with the original contract with Brasco International, Inc., which required the County to obtain new quotes for the bus shelter, AND

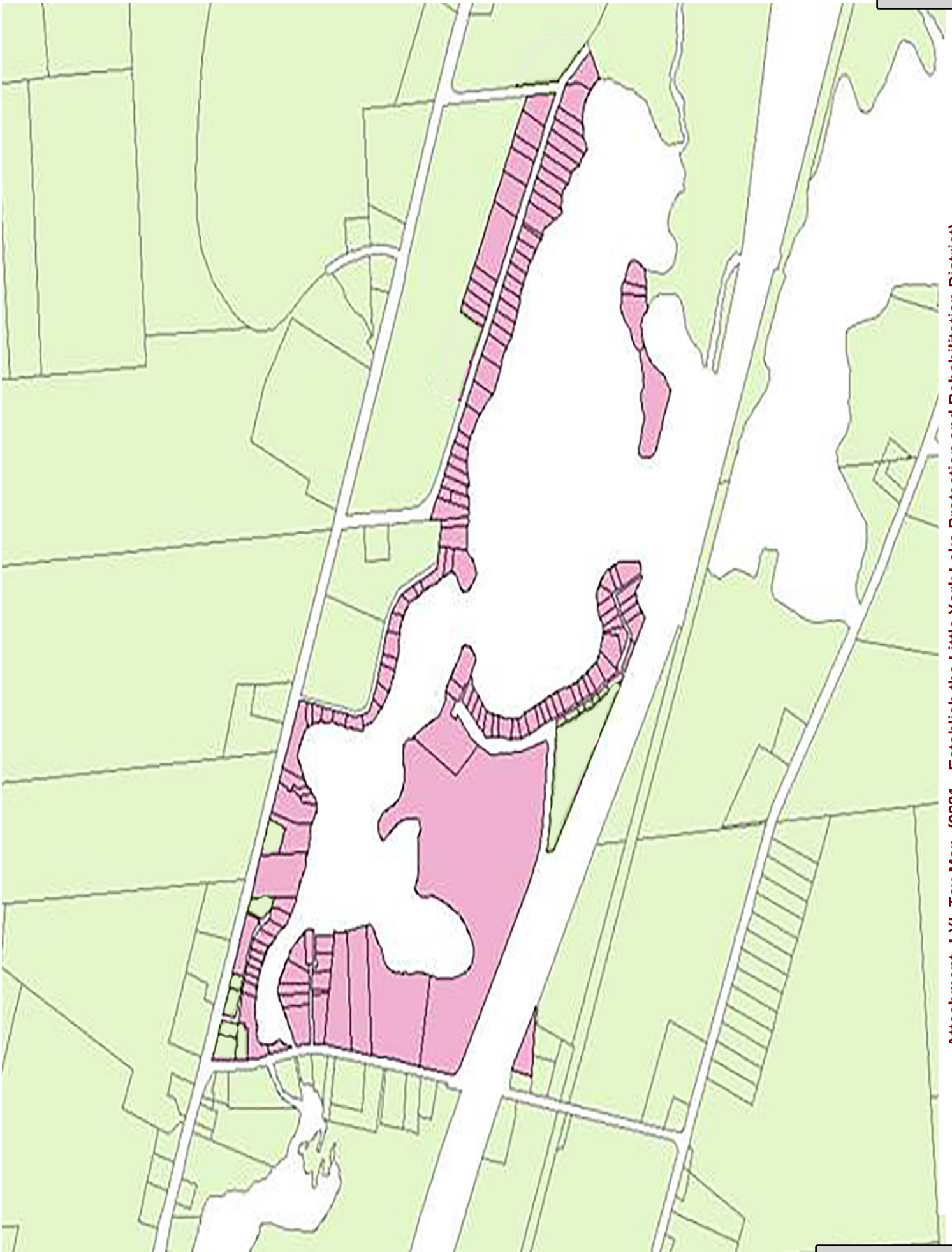

Re: Little York Lake

Dear Ms. Hempstead:

Enclosed please find paperwork which requests that the Cortland County Legislature create a lake protection and rehabilitation district around Little York Lake. Our lake has a history of water quality and weed issues which residents around the lake have been battling for years. The creation of our proposed Little York Lake Protection and Rehabilitation District will help to assure that the lake will be protected and improved for years to come. We are proposing a county district because the lake is within two towns. The existence of this district will benefit both the landowners around the lake and the county as a whole. Property values will be maintained, and the costs will be shared fairly among those properties that lie within the district boundaries.

County Law Section 250.4-a allows the county legislature to create the district we are proposing. Section 253 of the law provides that the process can be started by the submission of a petition “executed and acknowledged” by at least twenty-five owners of taxable property situated within the proposed district. Maps of the proposed district showing the boundaries and the identification of all parcels within the district are also required.

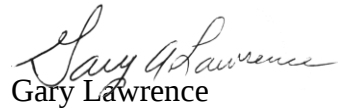
The documents which are enclosed meet all those requirements. County Law Section 254 provides that upon the acceptance of the above referenced documents the County legislature may call a public hearing to consider the proposal to establish the district. We respectfully request that the legislature accept this Petition and schedule a public hearing. We are proposing that the district operate under the general supervision of the Cortland County Soil and Water Conservation District. We are also proposing that this district funding be based only on the assessed value of property within the district. The initial budget we are proposing is 94 mil. At this rate the tax on a typical one or two family home would be approximately \$141.

As an additional point of information, please be aware that this district can be created without any approvals from the State of New York. The State Comptroller’s Office is only involved when a district proposes to incur debt, which is not the case here. We would be happy to provide contact information with that office if there are any questions. We understand that this process

begins by being considered by a committee or committees of the legislature. We would appreciate any guidance you can provide to get this before the full legislature as soon as possible.

AGRICULTURE AND PRIVATE LAND CONSERVATION

Agricultural Environmental Management (AEM) – Ag Planning and Best Management Practice (BMP) Implementation – Staff continue grazing, buffer, and farmstead planning. We are also working on a design for a barnyard water management project. Our final three agricultural water quality improvement projects slated for this season are underway. One pasture management system improvement project for laneways and two stream corridor management systems with stream channel stabilization and buffers are under construction. The wet weather this summer has created delays, and we are hopeful that the work can get completed this fall.

We are reviewing two new comprehensive nutrient management plans (cnmps) completed this summer. These plans will provide the farms with manure and fertilizer recommendations, including place, source, rates and timing, as well as identify other BMPs that may be implemented to address identified resource concerns. The farms will be eligible to apply for financial assistance to implement the planned BMPs.

COMMUNITY NATURAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT AND PLANNING

Culvert Rehabilitation – The two Skaneateles Lake watershed and three Chesapeake Bay watershed culvert replacement and stream corridor stabilization projects planned for 2021 implementation have all been postponed by the respective municipal sponsors. We have secured grant extensions, and with permits already approved, we are planning for implementation in early summer 2022.

The three other projects slated for completion are in the Cayuga Lake watershed, Town of Virgil and design work is underway.

Landfill Water Quality – The fourth quarter of 2021 Landfill Monitoring is scheduled. Coordination for 2022 work has begun.

Community Planning and Water Quality Protection – The Dry/Otter Creek aquifer monitoring report is being reviewed. Findings are consistent with previous monitoring.

PROGRAMS AND EDUCATION

Conservation Field Day – About 120 sixth grade students attended the Conservation Field Day last Friday, October 1st. Natural resource professionals and volunteers shared their knowledge of conservation related topics like wildlife management, soil health, ponds, forestry, orienteering, green energy, composting, and boating, outdoor, and firearm safety. Materials are also available on our website for schools/classrooms that were unable to attend the in-person event.

ADMINISTRATION

We are currently without administrative support in the office and are seeking to fill a temporary Secretary/Treasurer position.
