Abolish Nutrition Program Manager/Abolish Assistant Director of Area Agency on Aging/Create Deputy Director of Area Agency on Aging – Aging Services/Create Deputy Director of Area Agency on Aging – Nutrition Services Cortland County Area Agency on Aging

WHEREAS, the needs of the Area Agency on Aging will be better served by abolishing one (1) full-time Nutrition Program Manager position and one (1) full-time Assistant Director of Area Agency on Aging and creating one (1) Deputy Director of Area Agency on Aging - Aging Services position and one (1) Deputy Director of Area Agency on Aging - Nutrition Services position, AND

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends the abolition and creation of these positions, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that one (1) position of Nutrition Program Manager (Grade 12 Management Compensation Plan, \$46,813-62,308, competitive class, full-time) and one (1) position of Assistant Director of Area Agency on Aging (Grade 10, Management Compensation Plan, \$54,098-72,005,

competitive class, full-time) be and hereby are abolished effective September 22, 2022, AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that one (1) position of Deputy Director of Area Agency on Aging - Aging Services (Grade 8, Management Compensation Plan, \$62,517-83,211, competitive class, full-time) and one (1) positions of Deputy Director of Area Agency on Aging - Nutrition Services (Grade 8, Management Compensation Plan, \$62,517-83,211, competitive class, full-time) be created with permission to fill effective September 22, 2022, AND BE IT FURTHER

Accept Sports Opportunity Funding - Youth Bureau/Health Department

WHEREAS, the New York State Office of Children and Family Services, through the Resource Allocation Plan has made available the sum of \$7,159 to Cortland County Youth Bureau, AND

WHEREAS, each municipal youth bureau will receive an allocation for the Sports Opportunity Funding to serve children and youth ages 6-17 based on the population of eligible youth in the county, AND

WHEREAS, the County Youth Bureau has designated the funds to the various county municipalities and agencies for the year 2022 and for which a copy is in the County Youth Bureau Office, AND

WHEREAS, the 2022 County Budget will need to be amended as follows:

RESOLVED, that the County Administrator and Public Health Director, upon review and approval by the County Attorney or designee, and subject to appropriation of the funding by the Legislature, are hereby authorized and directed to execute the Resource Allocation Planning Agreement with the NY State Office of Children and Family Services and contract with approved agencies, AND BE IT FURTHER,

RESOLVED, that the Treasurer's office is authorized to pay from the appropriate expense account and that in the event that the county does not receive the appropriate funds from the NY State Office of Children and Family Services, the County shall not be liable to pay any of its own funds to meet any deficiency under the terms of the contract, AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, the Director of Finance shall carryover all unused grant funds to the subsequent year(s) budget covered by the grant, per the approved grant agreement.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 3

Authorize Agreement Qualified Individual Assessment Services - Department of Social Services

WHEREAS, the Cortland County Department of Social Services must contract with authorized agencies to provide Qualified Individual Assessment Services to determine the appropriateness of placement in a Qualified Residential Treatment Program, AND

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Family First Prevention Services Act (FFPSA) an independent assessment of a child in foster care placed in a Qualified Residential Treatment Program (QRTP) is required to make determinations, including, but not limited to, whether the placement in the QRTP is appropriate, AND

WHEREAS, the assessment must be completed within 30 days of placement of the child in the QRTP, AND

WHEREAS, each assessment must utilize a federally approved functional assessment tool that is age-appropriate and evidence based, AND

WHEREAS, the standards for the timing, process, content of the assessment and the qualifications for who may conduct the assessment are set forth in federal and New York State statute, regulation and policy, AND

WHEREAS, the Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) has issued a model contract to be used for the purchase of Qualified Individual Assessment Services, AND

WHEREAS, payments for such services will be made from the Program Expense Account A60105.54800, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Administrator, upon review by the County Attorney or designee, and subject to appropriation of funding by the Legislature, be and hereby is authorized and directed to execute contractual agreements for the time period 10/1/2022 – 12/31/2023 for Qualified Individual Assessment Services with providers authorized by the New York State Office of Children and Family Services.

Abolish Part Time Safe Harbour Coordinator & Full Time MDT Facilitator/Create Full Time MDT Facilitator/Safe Harbour Coordinator Position - Department of Social Services/Child Advocacy Center

WHEREAS, the needs of the Department of Social Services - Child Advocacy Center will be better served by abolishing one (1) part time Safe Harbour Coordinator position and abolishing one (1) full time Multidisciplinary Team (MDT) Facilitator position and creating one (1) full-time MDT Facilitator/Safe Harbour Coordinator position, AND

WHEREAS, the Health & Human Services Committee recommends the abolition and creation of these positions, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that one (1) position of Safe Harbour Coordinator (Grade 13 CSEA, \$20.2732-\$25.5331/hr. competitive, part-Time 17 Hours/Week, No Benefits) and that one (1) position of MDT Facilitator (Grade 13 CSEA, \$20.2732-\$25.5331/hr, competitive class, full-time 35 hours/week with benefits) be and hereby is abolished effective September 30, 2022 at midnight, AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that one (1) position of MDT Facilitator/Safe Harbour Coordinator (Grade 13 CSEA, \$20.2732-\$25.5331/hr, competitive class, full-time 35 hours/week with benefits) be created with permission to fill effective October 1, 2022 at 12:01 am.

Authorize 2022-2023 Contract with New York State Office of Victim Services, Accept Grant Funds to Support Cortland County Child Advocacy Center - Cortland County Department of Social Services

WHEREAS, a Child Advocacy Center (“CAC”) has been created in Cortland County to facilitate the most efficient and effective handling of cases involving child victims of sexual and physical abuse, which program is funded by New York State grants through the New York State Office of Victim Services (“OVS”), AND

WHEREAS, the grants will be received by Cortland County on behalf of the Child Advocacy Center, a division of the Department of Social Services by contract with OVS assigning the Child Advocacy Center with authority and responsibility to administer grant funds, which OVS advises will total \$133,813.26 for the OVS fiscal year 2022, to pay the expenses of running the CAC, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Administrator, upon review and approval by the County Attorney or designee, be and hereby is authorized to sign an agreement for the time period of October 1, 2022 through September 30, 2023 with OVS, and the DA be and hereby is authorized to administer funds received from OVS for the CAC, in an amount not to exceed \$133,813.26, AND BE IT FURTHER

Mental Health Abolish/Create Mental Health Program Aide (3 Full Time Positions, 1 Part Time Position), Continuing Day Treatment Specialist/Mental Health Rehabilitation Specialists (4 Full Time Positions, 1 Part Time Position) - Mental Health Department

WHEREAS, the needs of the Mental Health Department will be better served by abolishing three (3) full-time Mental Health Program Aide positions, one (1) part-time Mental Health Program Aide position and one (1) full-time Continuing Day Treatment Specialist position and creating four (4) full-time Mental Health Rehabilitation Specialist positions and one (1) part-time Mental Health Rehabilitation Specialist position, AND

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends the abolition/creation of these positions, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that three (3) positions of Mental Health Program Aide (Grade 8 CSEA, \$17.3185-21.8118/hr, competitive class, full time) and one (1) position of Mental Health Program Aide (Grade 8, CSEA, competitive class, part-time) and one (1) position of Continuing Day Treatment Specialist (Grade 15, CSEA, \$21.6766-27.3006/hr, competitive class, full time) be and hereby are abolished effective September 22, 2022 at midnight, AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED, that four (4) positions of Mental Health Rehabilitation Specialist (Grade 16, CSEA, \$22.4261-28.2445, competitive class, full-time) and one (1) position of Mental Health Rehabilitation Specialist (Grade 16, CSEA \$22.4261-28.2445/hr, competitive class, part-time, up to 17 hrs/wk, no benefits) be created with the current incumbents filling the positions effective September 23, 2022 at 12:01 am.
