1. Compared to last month, there has been a slight decrease in new cases assigned to the Public Defender's Office. In particular, the number of criminal cases have been steady while there has been a decrease in the number of family cases. See enclosed chart.
2. The office is within our budget.
3. Our office continues to pursue and collect grant revenues.
4. Our office continues in our efforts to recruit attorneys to fill vacant positions. We received no applications in January, but did receive two resumes from unqualified candidates. The office did fill a position on our support staff with the hiring of a new paralegal.
