WHEREAS, this grant money shall also be used to continue to provide salary and fringe benefits funding for a part-time Client Liaison Specialist position to assist attorneys in the day-to-day interaction with clients, including client ancillary projects for assistance with resources provided by third parties, AND

WHEREAS, as required by the County or NYS Office of Indigent Legal Services, the Public Defender shall collect and report data annually, in statistical and narrative form, to measure this project and shall continuously analyze and evaluate case outcomes to ensure effective use of the funds, NOW THEREFORE BE IT

Dear JPS Chair Preston:

1. Comparing the first five months of 2022 to the first five months of 2021:
 - a. Total Cases are roughly the same, maybe trending up a little bit.
 - b. Family Court Cases are down.
 - c. Criminal Cases are up compared to last year (with arraignments at first appearance) up quite a bit.
2. In 2022 so far, we are within our budget.
3. We continue to pursue and collect grant revenues. Please see the two (2) resolutions on for this month seeking approval to accept grant funding totaling \$450,522 over three (3) years.
4. We are currently down one (1) part-time assistant public defender.
