AGENDA ITEM NO. 1

Authorize Agreement with Cayuga County Addiction Services for Medicated Assisted Treatment (MAT) - Sheriff/Jail

WHEREAS, Governor Hochul signed into law legislation (Chapter 432 of the Laws of 2021), which generally serves to allow incarcerated individuals with certain substance use disorders the opportunity to participate in a medication assisted treatment (MAT) program and Subsequent lawmaking (Chapter 432 of the Laws of 2021) postponed the effective date of the legislation to October 7, 2022, AND

WHEREAS, there is no service provider in Cortland County that can provide needed medication for MAT program, AND

WHEREAS, Cayuga County Addiction Services, (CARS) 334 W. State Street, Ithaca, NY 14850, will provide the medication with compliance with MAT program to Cortland County Jail at a cost of \$75 per week, per incarcerated individual that is receiving the medication. NOW THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County Administrator and the Sheriff of Cortland County, upon review and approval by the County Attorney or designee, be and herby are authorized to contract with Cayuga Addiction Recovery Services, CARS, for the period beginning January 1, 2023.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 2

Authorize Lease Contract - 911 Telephone System - Department of Emergency Response & Communications

WHEREAS, the Cortland County Department of Emergency Response purchased a Vesta 911 telephone system from Frontier Communications in 2016 that included 5 years of preventative maintenance, expiring December 31, 2022, AND

WHEREAS, the Vesta 911 telephone system is integral to the operation of Cortland County's 911 center and is scheduled to be refreshed; replacing and upgrading major and minor components of the system to provide for continued high availability use during 911 and other emergency calls, and

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Response and Communications has sought pricing for a refresh/upgrade/5 year maintenance plan of its Vesta 911 telephone system with the following proposals:

Motorola Solutions: \$567,968

Frontier Communications \$678,461
, AND

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Response and Communications seeks to take advantage of 4th quarter 2022 pricing for the Vesta 911 system upgrades, AND

WHEREAS, the Department of Emergency Response and Communications previously leased the County's radio system with Motorola paying that lease off early by leveraging available grant funding. The Department of Emergency Response and Communications seeks to lease the upgrades to the Vesta 911 telephone system enabling the County to seek grant funding to potentially pay off the lease early as opposed to funding completely from the County's operating budget, AND

WHEREAS, Motorola Solutions has proposed five-year lease term, resulting in annual proposed payments of \$130,925. The initial lease payment is included in the Department of Emergency Response & Communication's 2023 adopted budget, THEREFORE NOW BE IT

RESOLVED, that the County administrator be authorized to execute a five-year lease contract with Motorola Solutions, upon approval of the County attorney or their designee, for a refresh / upgrade / preventative maintenance of the County's Vesta 911 telephone system for the County's 911 center.
